

Commission Minutes April 17, 2017

The Board of Washington County Commission met in regular session on Monday April 10, 2017 in the commission room at the Washington County Courthouse. Members present: Tim Mueller, 1st District Commissioner, David Willbrant, 2nd District Commissioner, Gary Ouellette, 3rd District Commissioner and Diana Svanda, County Clerk to record minutes.

Consent Agenda items:

No consent agenda items noted.

Gary Ouellette reported that Joel Voelker called him about the rock on the road and how it is ruining tires.

Overtime was discussed no decision made.

Marlene Stamm- Sanitarian, presented quarterly update, and also discussed changing Marlene from contract to a full time employee, no decision made.

Justin Novak- Road & Bridge supervisor, there were 3 bids received for diesel and unleaded gas, David Willbrant made the motion to accept the low bid of Kramer Oil, Gary Ouellette seconded the motion, all in favor, motion passed.

Tim Mueller moved and David Willbrant seconded to approve the payroll change notice for Emil Miller as a returning summer hire at Noxious Weed, motion carried with Mueller and Willbrant voting in favor and Ouellette abstaining. Mueller asked Bruna to prepare a cost-benefit analysis of County's recycling program.

The Board discussed a resolution regarding burn bans with Elizabeth Hiltgen, County Attorney.

David Willbrant made the motion to adjourn at 12:20 Gary Ouellette seconded the motion all in favor, motion passed.
